<p><b>CT DOTS Introductory Training</b>            The Connecticut Documentation and Observation for Teaching System is a framework to guide early care and education providers in a process of monitoring children’s progress on the skills, abilities, and behaviors in the CT ELDS. The first training addresses how the documents are organized and the process of collecting evidence of children’s learning and development using three strategies: naturalistic observations, planned experiences and family input.
